100% OF STUDENT IN DARCA'S HAMMER HIGH SCHOOL PASS THE BAGRUT

All students in the Darca Hammer Religious High School in Bat Yam play a role in the schools' success. New Ministry of Education data indicates that this past school year saw 100% of these students matriculate successfully by passing the Bagrut exam.

It is important to note that this school is not selective and accepts students from all over the city and from varying degrees of socioeconomic backgrounds. It is clear that a diverse student body does not negatively impact them, but instead fosters a learning environment with exceptional outcomes.

These above-average outcomes are not only seen in this school. The Darca Network is seeing similarly high rates in their schools in Gedera. Darca Ilan and Asaf Ramon also achieved 100% matriculation successes. A third Gedera High School is at 96.4%; only six years ago this school's average stood at 54%.

The Ministry of Education data shows that the network, which was established six years ago to strengthen schools in the periphery and enable them to lead in the field of secondary education, has succeeded in its mission. Darca Schools across the country are seeing incredible success in the Bagrut passing rates. Darca Kiryat Malachi Gymnasia has a passing rate of 87.4%, Darca Ashkelon has a passing rate of 85%, and Darca Danciger in Kiryat Shmona is at 82%.

The Darca Network attributes its far-reaching success to innovative learning methods and the development of a culture of excellence that encourages a love of learning, originality and critical thinking. First to market pedagogical method such as "escape the room" gaming classrooms as well as enrichment programs like diplomacy, chess, bridge and leadership development all foster an enjoyable place to learn paralleled with incredible achievement and results.
